Dear Parents,

Congratulations on your purchase of a Christiane Wegner Product. This high quality product - manufactured in Germany – has been designed and developed with safety, comfort and functionality in mind

Please take the time to read this manual carefully before using this product and keep it in a safe place for future reference.

To meet the DIN EN 1130 requirements and to provide your child with maximum safety please observe the following safety instructions:

1. Always stand your Cradle on a flat surface.
2. Small children should not be allowed to play near the Cradle unsupervised.
3. Always apply the brakes when your child is left unattended in the cradle.
4. Stop using the cradle if some of the listed parts are missing or if parts are damaged.
5. **Stop using the cradle as soon as your child can sit up by itself**
6. All assembly parts must be mounted correctly. Ensure there are no loose screws, your child could accidentally catch its soother chain and become a strangulation hazard.
7. Only use the supplied Mattress. The distance between mattress rim and basket Must be at least 200mm.
8. Ensure proper ventilation. Mattress should be turned over daily to avoid build up of mould.
9. Ensure your cradle is placed away from open fires or other heat sources such as electric or gas heaters etc.
10. The curtain rail can be adjusted to the desired position by bending.

After purchase there is a 12 month warranty from you dealer on Manufacture or Material faults. Damages caused by wear and tear, external influences and abnormal handling are exempt from the warranty period. Please keep your receipt so that we may process your warranty request.

Bassinet Lisa 9616

Contents	Assembly parts
1 x Basket	4 x Bushing
1 x Mattress	4 x Castors (2 of which are fitted with brakes)
1 x Veil rod	4 x connecting screws 25 mm
1 x Stand consisting of	4 x connecting screws 50 mm
4 x squared rods	1 x Allen key
2 x round rods	
2 x Connecting Beam	

Tap the 4 bushings into the pre-drilled holes on the rods.
Subsequently push in the castors until the metal pins can no longer be seen.

Now screw the rods with the basket by using the M6 x 25 mm screws (turn the basket on its side).
Use the 4 outer pre-drilled holes on the bottom of the basket.

Pull the fabric storage rack onto the rods. Now screw both connecting rods with the squared and round rods
Using the M6 x 50 mm screws.

See below illustration. Please use the Bassinet Lisa as illustrated. No parts should be missing.
Ensure that all screws are tightened. We recommend that you tighten the screws
from time to time if you wheel your Bassinet frequently.

Bassinet Stella and Luna 85... and Skirt

Contents	Assembly parts
1 x basket	2 x Connecting screws 25 mm
1 x Mattress (82 x 43 cm)	4 x Connecting screws 35 mm
1 x Veil rod	8 x Plastic washer (21x37x3 mm)
2 x Stand parts	4 x Plastic washer (19,2x34x1,5 mm)
1 x Connecting Beam	4 x Plastic inserts/wedge
4 x Castors	1 x Allen Key SW 4
(Bassinet with Canopy has no Veil rod)	

Bassinet Assembly

Start by screwing both frame parts to the connecting Beam using the 4 x 35 mm (see below image) connecting screws with the Allen Key.

Place 2 plastic washers (21x37x3) on each Pivot pin. Push the casters onto the Pivot pins and the plastic inserts into the pre-drilled holes on the axle and push together. Do not push together with force otherwise the axle may split.

Should you wish to increase the sturdiness of your Bassinet simply place an additional Washer (19,2x334x1,5) onto the pivot pin.

Place the basket onto the stand and screw together with 2 connecting screws (25 mm). Please check that all connections have been assembled firmly.

The same procedure may be followed for the assembly of the **Bassinets** leaving out the frame Assembly.

The Upholstery can now be pulled onto the basket and attached to the frame with the sewn on ribbons.

Assemble the Canopy/Veil rod as illustrated in order to provide for firm adjustment settings.

When the Mattress is inserted the Basket padding is secured. With the Canopy version – pull the Veil onto the veil rod and tie with both ribbons.

Bassinet Maxi 9019

Contents

1 x Basket
1 x Veil rod
1 x Mattress (82 x 43 cm)
1 Stand

Assembly parts

4 x Bushing
4 x Castors (all with Brakes)
2 x Connecting screws 25 mm
1 x Allen Key

Assembling the Bassinet

Tap the 4 Bushings into the pre-drilled holes on the bottom of the stand.
Subsequently push in the castors until the metal pins can no longer be seen
The Castors fitted with brakes should be at the front.

Place the basket onto the stand and screw together with the 2 connecting screws (25 mm)
using the Allen Key.

Attach the skirt to the Basket and push the Veil rod into the pre-drilled holes on the frame.

Place the mattress into the Bassinet.
Pull the Veil onto the veil rod and tie with both ribbons.

Please remove all packaging before use.
